

Deed of Grant of Exclusive Right of Burial

By Virtue of the powers conferred by the Local Authorities' Cemeteries Order 1977 (hereinafter referred to as "the said Order") on burial authorities constituted under the Local Government Act 1972 the Hollesley Parish Council (hereinafter called "the Council") acting as a burial authority constituted under the said Act.

2. It is the Deed Holder(s) responsibility to inform the Cemetery Office of any changes to their contact details.
3. An interment can only take place if the Exclusive Right of Burial is within the valid term.
4. If the Exclusive Right of Burial has expired, then a burial can only take place if this deed is back dated and the necessary fees are paid.
