


**Purchased Graves, Conditions Covering Burial**

1. The Exclusive Right of Burial is granted for a period of 25 years dating from the first burial.
2. The whole of the grave space will be turfed flat and mown by Cemetery staff.
3. All memorials should be a maximum of 2 feet 6 inches (0.76 metres) in height by 2 feet 6 inches (0.76 metres) in width with a base no more than 12 inches deep (0.30 metres).
4. The grave will be maintained in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Hollesley New Cemetery
